SLIDETRAX TOOLBOARD

The Slide Trax Toolboard is designed as a modular component to the Slide Trax Dashboard. The Toolboard mounts to the Dashboard via two slots, allowing it to be slid forward for access or pushed away for freedom of movement. Festooned with multiple cutouts and slots to contain and organize fishing tools such as pliers, fillet knives, jar baits, lures, rod park, etc., the Toolboard is also predrilled to accept a Scotty #241 rod holder base. The application of the Toolboard is limited only by your imagination.

TOOLS REQUIRED

Phillips head screwdriver
Adjustable wrench

INSTALLATION:

1. The Toolboard is intended to be mounted beneath the Dashboard. Actual position side-to-side is at your option.
2. Once desired position is determined, align slots in Toolboard with two of the closest row of holes drilled in Dashboard.
3. Place flat washer over screw, insert screw through hole in Dashboard and through corresponding slot in Toolboard. Secure underneath Toolboard with second flat washer secured by lock nut.
4. Repeat installation of hardware in opposite slot on Toolboard.
5. Tighten the hardware to desired tension. You can snug up the Toolboard fully tight if the ability to slide the board forward and back is not important. If you wish to have the board able to move, leave some slack in the mounting hardware.
